POLICIES & PROCEDURES

1. ESTABLISHING AN ACCOUNT:

Account application forms are available for download at www. taborsofsanangelo.com or call 1(800)328-8886 to have a form sent via fax or mail.

2. ORDERING:

A. A written work order is required. Orders will not be placed into the production schedule until ALL instructions and materials are received. Work order forms are available for download at www.taborsofsanangelo.com or call 1(800)328-8886 to have a form sent via fax or mail.

* WRITTEN OR VERBAL QUOTES WILL NOT BE USED AS A WORK ORDER.

- **B.** The vendor/pattern/color/yardage of materials sent must be specified on all orders. Please provide a physical or digital swatch whenever possible. If the fabric does not have a printed selvage showing the correct side and the up/down of the fabric, mark the swatch. Otherwise, we will assume the correct side is rolled to the inside of the bolt; and that we should use our judgment as to which way is up.
- C. Changes to existing orders must be in writing.

3. SHIPPING:

Inbound

- **A.** Materials must be labeled with account name and PO#/ sidemark.
- **B.** Materials must be shipped to us prepaid.
- C. There is a pressing charge for fabrics received wrinkled.
- **D.** Fabrics rolled on a tube seldom wrinkle in shipment.

Outbound

- **A.** We ship via UPS. Oversized packages will ship via motor freight FOB San Angelo, TX.
- **B.** Indicate type of service with these details:
 - Ground, 3 Day Select, 2nd Day Air or Next Day Air.
 - Special shipping instructions.
 - Amount of insurance.

4. FABRIC FLAWS:

Tabors of San Angelo will not assume responsibility for customer's flawed fabric. It is the sole responsibility of the customer to verify fabric and inspect for flaws prior to our receiving the fabric. Flawed fabrics received in drop shipments are the responsibility of the customer and/or supplier.

5. SHEETS:

Fabrication from sheets always requires an additional charge for pressing and handling.

6. EXCESS MATERIALS:

Excess materials are returned unless otherwise specified.

7. REWORKS:



STANDARD SPECIFICATION

1. HEMS

Bottom Hems are 4" doubled, with color matched thread and either blindstitched or lock-stitched, depending on the fabric.

• Bulky fabric may require a 4" single hem.

Side Hems are 11/2", doubled, with color matched thread and either blind-stitched or lock-stitched, depending on the fabric.

Hand-sewn hems available at an additional charge.

2. FINISH WORK

Where side hems meet headers and bottom hems we hand sew using a hidden stitch for clean finished edges.

3. LINING

Lining is folded with the primary fabric at the headings, which leaves the primary fabric exposed on the back of the heading.

- hangs 3/4" shorter than the drapery.
- can be faced to the top of the drapery upon request.
- can be pillow cased upon request.

4. LINING HEMS

Standard Lining - e.g., Rain-No-Stain, Sateen and Thermal Suede, has a 11/2" top stitched double bottom hem.

Interlining – is serged at the bottom edge and is free hanging ½" shorter than the lining.

Blackout Lining – is serged at the bottom edge.

5. WEIGHTS

Covered lead weights are inserted in corners and at seams.

• Beaded Chain Weight available at an *additional charge*.

6. SEAMING

Widths/cuts of fabric are joined by serging with a safety and overlocking stitch unless the fabric dictates otherwise.

• Flat Felled Seams are available for an *additional charge*.

7. FULLNESS

Fullness is increased to the nearest width.

Comparable fullness - specify if fullness is to be exactly the same on draperies of different widths.

- 3 to 1 fullness is optimum.
- 2.5 to 1 fullness is standard.
- 2 to 1 fullness is minimum.

8. FABRIC DIRECTION

Fabric is sewn selvage-to-selvage.

9. SEAMLESS FABRICS (118" wide/railroaded)

Railroading - fabric turned sideways to use width as the length. Finished length has limitations:

- Pinch Pleated unlined, 4" doubled hems and headings yields 100" maximum length.
- Rod Pocket unlined, 1 1/2" pocket, 1" heading and 4" doubled hems yields 104" maximum length.

10. CALCULATING WIDTHS

A width is a cut of fabric, regardless of how wide it is. If a panel has a ¹/₂ width, it will be priced as a full width. Exception: Labor for wide fabrics (over 72") will be priced on a basis of $54^{\circ} = 1$ width.

11. THE MAXIMUM LENGTH WE WILL FABRICATE IS 246".

12. MATERIALS REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING/FABRICATION

When the workroom determines a product requires special handling and/ or fabrication methods we will contact you with the specifics, provide an estimated cost for the additional services and request your approval before proceeding. The determination is made prior to the materials being cut and put into production. Unfortunately, special handling requirements are not always apparent until after fabrication has begun. In such cases, Tabors will bill accordingly for additional labor and/or material costs incurred.

13. DELICATES/BEADED/OPEN WEAVES

May require hand-sewn hems and/or a handling charge.

14. VELVETS

- Hems are hand-sewn and *billed accordingly*.
 - 8" single bottom hems and 2" single side hems.
- Beaded chain weight will be added in bottom hems at an *additional charge*.
- 25% handling charge will be assessed.

15. PLAID/BURNOUT FABRICS

Woven/Printed Plaids and Burnout Fabrics cannot be pattern matched at top and bottom. Please specify preferred matching point.

16. CASEMENT FABRIC

Loosely woven casement fabric can be sensitive to atmospheric changes and will shrink and stretch in varying weather conditions. We cannot be responsible for these qualities, and suggest that casement fabric not be used when absolute evenness of a hem line is necessary. We do recommend that casement fabric be unlined only.

17. COMMERCIAL APPLICATIONS

Hems and headers machine finished for durability.

18. WRINKLE REMOVAL

Draperies are fan or seam folded and carefully packaged; however, due to transit handling, some creases and wrinkles will occur. Draperies should be hung as soon as possible upon receipt. Most wrinkles should "hang out" in a very short time. Should you desire to press draperies, follow the fabric manufactures recommendations.

PLEATED DRAPERIES

19. PLEATS

Draperies have three-fold pleats unless single-fold or double-fold pleats are specified.

- Clear monofilament thread is used to stitch down and tack pleats.
- Color matched thread is available upon request.
- Stitch down: no additional charge.
- Pleats: must be hand tacked at an *additional charge*.

20. HEADINGS

Headings are 4" doubled with heavyweight 4" Hovotex buckram.

- Bulky fabric will have a 4" single top heading.
- Sheers *must* have doubled headings.

21. RETURNS

Returns are 4". If you want a different size return please specify (minimum $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " to accommodate the side hem).

21. OVERLAPS/LEADING EDGES

Overlaps/Leading Edges are 4". If you want a different size overlap/leading edge please specify (minimum $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to accommodate the side hem).

22. HOOK SETTING

Hook setting is the distance from top of hook to top of drapery

- Hooks set at 1 ¹/₂" unless otherwise specified.
- Rod style Hook settings
 - a. White Utility Rod 1 ½"
 - b. Decorator Rod ½"
 - c. Rings ½"

23. PLEATING

Comparable Fullness – specify if pleats and pleat spacing are to be exactly the same on draperies of different widths.

Pleat to Pattern – specify if Plaids/Stripes/Patterns are to be matched from pleat to pleat. The pattern must be symmetrical and ample fabric must be allowed to achieve the desired match. Not all fabrics can be pleated to pattern.


SHOWER CURTAINS

Fabricated with over-locked seams, weighted corners, and 1 $\mspace{12mu}$ double side hems.

- Headings are available with button holes or 3/8" ID grommets in brass or nickel.
- Button holes and grommets are set to match standard 72" wide shower liners.



MEASURING WINDOWS



- 1. From left of window trim to nearest obstruction
- 2. Window opening width: inside at top, middle, and bottom
- 3. Molding to molding
- 4. Right of window to nearest obstruction
- 5. Ceiling to window opening
- 6. Window opening length: inside at left, right, and middle (for wide windows)
- 7. Top of molding to sill
- 8. Top of molding to bottom of sill apron
- 9. Top of molding to floor
- 10. Floor to ceiling (check at least two places)
- 11. Width of molding
- 12. Depth (or thickness) of molding trim and/or window
- 13. Any additional measurement pertaining to design of treatment

Swags/Jabots/ Swag Valances

- 1. Mounted on a fabric covered pine dust board or on a tacking strip for mounting on site to your board or pole.
- 2. We DO NOT attach Velcro to tacking strips.
- **3.** Tabors recommends that you furnish a sketch with your written order.

SWAGS

- **1.** Swags are cut bias and lined with white cotton sateen. (Ivory available)
- 2. A single swag will cover 24" to 48".
- **3.** Depths up to 20" will have 5 folds, depths of 20" to 24" will have 6 folds

JABOTS

- **1.** Jabots are self or contrast lined.
- 2. Face width 8" to 12" with 4 equal folds.
- 3. Tapered 18"
- 4. Bottom of return is pointed

SWAG VALANCES

- **1.** Constructed in cuts and pattern matched.
- 2. Cut selvage to selvage.
- **3.** Swags are lined in white cotton sateen. (Ivory available)
- **4.** Trumpets and returns have a facing strip.
- 5. Tails/Jabots are self or contrast lined.

SWAGS

- (2 yards per swag)
 - For patterned fabrics: 72" ÷ vertical repeat = number of repeats (round up) × repeat = cut length per swag



- Finished length + 5" working allowance = cut length for *each side* of jabot
- For patterned fabrics: Cut length ÷ vertical repeat = number of repeats (round up) × repeat = cut length per each side of jabot

Rod Mounted Valances

1. HEMS

Bottom hems are 3" doubled, sewn with color matched thread and, depending on the fabric, either blind-stitched or lock-stitched.Bulky fabric may require a 3" single hem.

Side hems are 1¹/₂" doubled, sewn with color matched thread and, depending on the fabric, either blind-stitched or lock-stitched.

Hand-sewn hems available at an *additional charge*.

2. SHAPED BOTTOMS

Shaped Bottoms are finished with a facing strip and blackout lined to prevent silhouetting.

3. LINING

Lining hangs ³/₄" shorter than the valance

- Optionally can be faced to the top of the valance upon request.
- Optionally can be pillow-cased upon request.

4. LINING HEMS

Standard lining Eg: Rain-No-Stain, Sateen and Thermal Suede has a 1¹/₂" top stitched double bottom hem.

- **Interlining** is serged at the bottom edge and will be free hanging ¹/₂" shorter than the lining.
- **Blackout Lining** is set even with the bottom edge of the valance then the hem is folded up and over the lining and blind stitched.

5. SEAMING

Widths are joined by serging with a safety and overlocking stitch unless the fabric dictates otherwise.

6. FULLNESS

The fullness is *increased* to the nearest width.

- 3 to 1 fullness is optimum.
- 2.5 to 1 fullness is standard.
- 2 to 1 fullness is minimum.

Comparable fullness

Specify if valances of different widths are to have exact same fullness.

7. FABRIC DIRECTION

Fabric is sewn selvage-to-selvage.

8. CALCULATING WIDTHS

A width is a cut of fabric, regardless of how wide it is. If a valance has a $\frac{1}{2}$ width, it is priced as a full width. **Exception:** Labor for wide fabrics (over 72") or railroaded fabrics is priced on a basis of 54" = 1 width.

- **1. Mounted** on a 1³/₄" x ³/₄" fabric covered board. Also available on ³/₄", 3¹/₂", 5¹/₂" and 7¹/₂" boards.

- **11. Austrian Shades** tend to "hour-glass" in on the sides. They are not recommended for inside mount unless there are drapery side panels covering the edges.
- **12. Sheers and casements** are usually unsatisfactory for Roman Shades. It is suggested that the designer consider the alternatives to these fabric.

Late in 2009, the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), working with the industry group, Window Covering Manufacturers Association (WCMA), announced a plan to improve the manufacturing standards for corded window treatments. On September 3, 2010 the 2nd Provisional American National Standard for Safety of Corded Window Covering Products ANSI/WCMA A100.1-2010(PS2) Revision of Provisional ANSI/WCMA A100-1-2009 was approved. 

Our loom patterns #600 "Channel" and #309 "Oveta" have some limitations.

- 1. Channel and Oveta are not suitable for fitted spreads. The channels "grow" slightly and this is unacceptable on fitted styles.
- 2. Channel and Ovata cannot be used if there is a vertical stripe pattern. Fabric tends to "sway" as it goes through the loom quilter and the slight difference in the print lines and the quilt pattern is objectionable

STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS

1. CUSTOM HAND-GUIDED OUTLINE QUILTING:

A single-needle lockstitch outline quilter uses two cotton top threads.

- The top thread is matched to the fabric background color. An alternate thread color can be specified at *no additional charge*.
- White thread is used on the lining side.
- Lined in White (standard) or Ivory 100% cotton sateen.
- 11 oz. (standard), 7 oz., or 3 oz. bonded polyester fiber fill.
- Fabric is seamed before quilting.
- Open area between quilt lines is approximately 6" (a hand span).
- Detailed quilting (quilt line closer than 6") is available at an *additional charge*.
- 4" spacing is the minimum available on Hand-Guided squares, diamonds and channels.
- Loft is largely determined by the size of the open spaces. For example, 8" squares are much loftier than 4" squares.
- When QUILTING ONLY, the widths/lengths must be 4 yards or less.
- Should the customer cut and seam their own fabric, use a double-sewn flat seam that is pressed open. The quilt top should be 10% longer and 10% wider than the desired finished unhemmed size.

2. CUSTOM TWIN-LINE MACHINE QUILTING:

We use a multi-needle lockstitch quilting machine.

- WHITE NYLON THREAD ONLY (we do not use plastic monofiliment) Thread cannot be color matched.
- White Rockland Mills Quilteze lining only.
- 11 oz. (standard) or 7 oz. bonded polyester fiber fill.
- Fabric will be quilted first then serged with seams visible on the back.
- DO NOT CUT OR SEW FABRICS TOGETHER!
- Fabrics must be in one piece and rolled on a tube.
- Fabric can be quilted in widths up to 56".
- Not suitable for pre-seamed or irregularly sized pieces.
- Prints will be matched by pattern after quilting if possible.
- Solids will be matched by quilting design.
- Not suitable for velvets, suedes, flocks or painted fabrics; however, these items can usually be outline quilted.

3. FILL WEIGHTS

- **a.** 11-ounce high loft fill is standard.
- **b.** 7-ounce for medium weight
- **c.** 3-ounce light weight (Available on Outline/Hand-Guided Quilting only)
- **d.** 7-ounce fill plus 1/4" foam for upholstery quilting (Available on Outline/ Hand-Guided Quilting only).

4. FINISHED BED MEASUREMENTS

(width of mattress x length of mattress x drop)

The standard measurements listed will be used if no measurements are provided. All spreads/coverlets will have a 22-inch pillow tuck.

5. MACHINE QUILTED TWIN THROWS

Since twin beds are 39" wide, you must specify whether you want the fabric seamed at the mattress edge or at the fabric selvage. Patterned fabrics seamed at the mattress edge usually will not pattern match, so consider using welt cord in the seams. Outline quilting is an alternative.

6. FITTED SPREADS/COVERLETS

Spread and coverlet side drops are railroaded. Drops can also be seamed selvage to selvage. Machine quilting in Channel and Oveta patterns is not suitable for fitted spreads or stripe fabrics.

YARDAGE CALCULATION FORMULA **BASED ON A SOLID 54" WIDE FABRIC**

Patterned or directional fabrics:

- A. Finished width + return (x2) + 4" working allowance ÷ fabric width = number of cuts (round up)
- **B. Finished length** + return + 4" working allowance + 5" for straight welt = cut length
 - For patterned fabrics, add one vertical pattern repeat for each cut of fabric involved.
- **C. Number of cuts** x cut length \div 36" = yardage required
- **Railroaded fabrics:**
- Finished width + return (x2) + 4" working allowance \div 36 = yardage required
- For patterned fabrics, add one vertical pattern repeat for each cut of fabric involved.

Bias welting will require additional yardage.

- 10. Legs are unattached to avoid damage in transit. Upon receipt simply slide them on.




